

About the Missouri Census Data Center

The Missouri State Library in the Office of the Secretary of State has been the lead agency for the United States Census Bureau's State Data Center Program since the program was initiated in the late 1970s. The program operates under a memorandum of understanding between the Office of the Secretary of State and the Census Bureau. The purpose of this partnership is to provide training opportunities, consultation services, and access to census information in a variety of formats to Missouri residents.

Coordinating members work closely with the lead agency and enrich the program by providing expertise and census support services in a variety of areas. These areas include: Web-based census applications, population projections, mapping and geographic information system (GIS) services, and business and economic analysis.
